

THE 360 CHAINROLL EXPERIENCE

@ BEFORE 360 CHAINROLL...

We ran a stalk stomper unit on all rolls for stubble management and fields planted to corn again the next season commonly received a pass with a stalk shredder to manage heavy amounts of residue prior to fall tillage.

10 WHAT CONVINCED YOU TO TRY 360 CHAINROLL?

We liked the ability to size & crimp stalks and improve our odds of having physical breakdown of the residue without the need to run a shredder across the field.

AFTER 360 CHAINROLL...

We were very pleased with how the product leaves stalk pieces right at the base of the plant, how it crimps & smashes the pieces, and how the top of the stubble left behind is mushroomed or almost shredded.

10 HOW DID 360 CHAINROLL COMPARE TO YOUR OEM ROLLS?

The 360 CHAINROLLs clearly pulled the stalks through the row unit better than the factory knife-to-knife rolls on our Case IH head. We liked the size of the residue pieces better than when we otherwise use a stalk shredder.

O DID CHAINROLL ADD VALUE OR EFFICIENCY TO YOUR FARM?

Where we are doing tillage for fields which will be corn-on-corn next season, we like how the residue passes through better without having to make a stalk shredder pass.

10 WILL THE RESULTS HAVE AN IMPACT ON NEXT YEAR'S CROP?

These results look to be ideal for helping to get the residue to begin breaking down so next spring we can run our no-till soybean planting pass with the confidence of doing a more uniform job.
